

1 phylum of flatworms **Word Bank:** type of symmetry in which several planes can be cut for mirror images **ANNELIDA** 10 circulatory system with no vessels **ARTHROPODA** 12 organisms that do not have a backbone **ASYMMETRY** 14 this means something is attached and doesn't move **BILATERAL** 15 phylum of starfish, sand dollars and sea urchins **CHORDATA** 18 phylum of roundworms **CLOSED** 20 this is the first animal **CNIDARIA** 21 phylum of insects, spiders and crabs **COMPLETE** 22 chordates use these organs to breathe **DIFFUSION** 23 type of symmetry in which one division is made making two mirror images **DORSAL** 24 phylum of animals with a backbone **DORSAL** 27 phylum of segmented worms **ECHINODERMATA** 28 the belly side of an organism **ENDOSKELETON** 29 type of nervous system where nerve cord is along back **EXOSKELETON HYDROSKELETON DOWN INCOMPLETE** a fluid filled skeleton INVERTEBRATE organisms that have backbones LUNGS type of skeleton found in echinoderms and chordates **MOLLUSCA** process used for respiration in sponges, jellyfish and worms **NEMATODA** phylum of snails, clams and squid **OCTOPUS OPEN** phylum containing sponges covers the body to protect internal organs **PLATYHELMINTHES** 11 circulatory system with vessels and heart **PORIFERA** 13 type of nervous system where nerve cord runs along the bottom **RADIAL** 16 type of digestive system with one opening **SESSILE** 17 phylum containing jellyfish and anemone **SPONGE** 19 type of digestive system with two openings **VENTRAL** 21 no symmetry **VENTRAL**
